- Drones (Bulgaria) Overlap and Echoes (Tonga) Heterophony (Hebrides)
- Ostinati (Estonia) Call and Response (Africa) Parallel Chords (Russia & Georgia)
- Polyphony (Renaissance) Multi-layered Interlocking Rhythmic Chants (Bali)

You will find this is Unforgettable, Life Enhancing Music that will Inspire and Transform and stretch the boundaries of your musical imaginations.

Sing Freedom

This course will help you develop the freedom and expressivity of your singing. To achieve this we will explore with you all the core elements of singing technique (to which Tonalis brings informed and enriching new viewpoints),

including how to:

- Develop the freedom of your BREATHING
- Expand the RANGE and DYNAMICS of your Voice
- Enliven your RESONANCE and the palette of your VOCAL COLOURS
- OPEN YOUR THROAT and FREE THE LARYNX from any constrictions
- Explore how each CONSONANT and VOWEL has unique moods and gestures
- Free your TONGUE, LIPS & JAW from any tensions that interfere with your voice.

The Imaginative Voice - Creativity in Voicework

Bring Metaphysical Dimensions into Singing

Whilst there are new singing pedagogies in evidence today that bring physical, psychological, global, stylistic and science-based perspectives into voicework, what is hardly present is a pathway that brings a spiritual understanding of the voice into singing. To go into this theme we will explore V. Werbeck's deep work on more subtle aspects of singing.

Songs of Courage and Hope

On this course Michael will help you remove any inhibitions which block access to the vocal potential you each have and establish an atmosphere of safety for you to move your voices from inside to outside without being stopped by the inner critics that often silence us.

To help with this Michael will introduce you to:

Freedom Songs from South African & African-American sources. These songs not only sound cultural journeys from slavery to freedom, but also help in liberating our own singing voices from imprisonment.

This course is for all vocal and music explorers who are passionate about singing, and who want to go deeper into singing and expand the borders of their voices.

It will meet the needs of all those who are searching for new holistic ways of singing, from amateurs and re-starters, to confident singers and voice professionals.
